

# SERMON DISCUSSION QUESTION

## ONE THING LEADS: WEEK 5

While anyone can take time to answer these questions individually, these questions are best discussed in a group! Not in a group yet? We want you in one! Head over to [southeastchristian.org](http://southeastchristian.org) to join a group in person or online, wherever you are - today!

In your own search for God's will, have you been looking more for a formula or more of a feeling? To say it another way, are you looking for a step-by-step plan or for a certain vibe? How have you experienced this in the past? Where do you think you get this idea of God's will from?

Read Genesis 41:1-16. What happened in Pharaoh's dream? Why do you think this troubled him so much? How does Joseph initially respond when asked to interpret the dream (Gen. 41:16)? Would you have responded like this? What does this response tell you about Joseph?

Joseph's patience in seeking God's will may have come from his mother (Genesis 30). When you think of people you know, who is someone that has taught you the most about knowing God's will? What has their example taught you? How did you see their confidence and trust in God's will?

Read Genesis 41:25-40. What was Joseph's interpretation of the dream? What did Joseph suggest that Pharaoh do in response to the dreams? Why do you think Pharaoh so quickly trusted Joseph, even though Joseph had just been a prisoner? Would you have done the same?

Kyle said: "Revelation is only half of following God's will; the other half is dedication." When you have a sense of where God is leading you, is it easy for you to obey? Why or why not? What are some of the obstacles that can keep us from being dedicated to God's will?

As we've been praying throughout this series, we've asked God to show us His will in a particular area of life. What would it look like for you to be dedicated to following His will in that area? Close your group in prayer, asking God to give you the strength and courage to follow however He leads you there.
